




A Parent's/Carer's Guide to Google Classroom




- 1. Type the following URL into your internet browser: https://education.nsw.gov.au/
- 2. Press the 'Log in' button in the top right corner. Press on 'Student Portal' to sign in.




3. You will find your log in information in your learning packs. Please remember this information is confidential and should not be shared with anyone else. Use your student portal username and password to log in. If you have a problem accessing this information in your learning packs please contact the school.




4. Once signed in, you will be taken to the student portal home page. On the right-hand side, you will see a section titled 'Learning.' Press on the 'show more' button to drop down and see more options.




5. When you have opened up the show more button you will see more options to choose from. You should see 'G Suite: Google Apps for Education.' Click on this button.




6. When **G Suite for Education** is open you will find **Google Classroom** on the left-hand side. Press on **Classroom**.




7. When you open Google Classroom, you will need to check that you are using the correct user. Press continue if this is your account.




8. Pick your role. You are a **student**.



9. Your teacher will have invited you to join your classroom. You will find your class on the right-hand side. Click join.



10. When you join the classroom, you will be taken straight to the stream. This is where you can see what activities and learning frameworks the teacher has posted.



Please ensure you read and discuss the Google Classroom protocols with your child to help create a safe and supportive learning environment.

We hope these instructions make it easy and simple for your child to access Google Classroom from home.
