Our new Kindergarten students also started this week and we welcome all of our new families to Lakemba PS. Students have had a great week making friends and getting to know Lakemba PS.


As we move into new classes next week it is important to communicate with your child's classroom teacher if you have any questions. Please remember to make an appointment with the teacher.

School as Community Centre News

Welcome families to the first newsletter for 2024 for the Lakemba Community Centre.
